

## **E. CONRAD HICKS, JR., M.D.**

Dr. Hicks is a well-respected Obstetrician-Gynecologist who focuses significantly on menopause and therapies for relieving menopausal symptoms. Practicing at Northeast OB-GYN in Fort Wayne, Indiana, Dr. Hicks' experience is not linked solely to clinical experience, but also to teaching experience. He often speaks publicly to audiences who are interested in learning more about menopause.

A 1984 graduate of the University of Virginia School of Medicine, Dr. Hicks moved on to New York City to do his residency at New York University-Bellevue Medical Center, and in 1987 he became Chief Resident of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology for a year. During the period from 1985 until 1999, Dr. Hicks occupied several academic positions in Departments of Gynecology and Obstetrics. They were: Teaching Assistant (1985-1987) and Clinical Instructor (1987-1988) at New York University School of Medicine, Clinical Instructor at George Washington University School of Medicine (1992-1997), Associate Faculty at Columbia Hospital for Women (1991-1997), Active Attending Staff at Sibley Memorial Hospital (1991-1997), and Clinical Instructor at the Medical College of Ohio (1998-1999).

Dr. Hicks is involved in several professional societies. Those include the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the American Medical Association, The District of Columbia Medical Society, the American Board of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the Fort Wayne Medical Society, the Indiana State Medical Association and the North American Menopause Society.

He is licensed and certified to practice gynecology and obstetrics in Arizona, Indiana, Maryland, Michigan, New York, Ohio, Virginia, and Washington, D.C.
